



## EVALUATION DAYS

The evaluation atmosphere should feel relaxed and comfortable. Although we recognize a level of stress during this process, we will do our best to help each athlete reach their potential. Athletes will show skills they already have developed and demonstrate potential to learn new skills.


Much of evaluations is based on potential, so it is beneficial for an athlete to attempt the most difficult skills they can perform SAFELY. Athletes should know their own limitations and not attempt skills beyond their current level of experience. Safety is the number one concern during evaluations.

Teams will be formed that will be able to score as high as possible in both difficulty and execution/technique in every aspect of the scoresheet. It is important to understand team members will not all have the exact same tumbling skills, etc. Stunting, jumping, performance and other aspects of the scoresheet are just as important as tumbling skills. Please reach out to the All-Star Director with any questions you have about team placements.

## ALL-STAR PREP/NOVICE

All-Star Prep/Novice is a great way to experience the competitive atmosphere of All-Star cheerleading with less financial obligations due to fewer competitions, minimal travel, and lower uniform costs. All-Star Prep/Novice teams will attend competitions in the greater Phoenix area, and one competition in Las Vegas. If you wish to be considered for our All-Star Prep/Novice program, please make sure you select "All-Star Prep/Novice" when registering online.

## ALL-STAR ELITE LEVELS 1-5

All-Star Levels 1-5 teams make up most of our program. These teams will compete in Phoenix, California, Las Vegas, and Nashville. Junior and Senior teams will also compete at The All-Star Worlds Championship in Orlando should they receive, and we accept, a ASW bid. These teams compete 2 days and out of state competitions will require a minimum 2- night hotel stay. Please make sure you select "All-Star Elite" when registering online.

## TEAM ANNOUNCEMENTS

Once we can finalize teams, each family member will be personally contacted by one of their coaches to notify them about the placement of their athlete, who their coaches will be and the days and times of their practices. We will have a required introductory parent meeting the last 30 minutes of each team's first team practice. Every athlete under 18 years of age should be represented by a parent at this meeting.

### **Athlete Movement**

It is important that everyone is given an opportunity to be considered for the level/team they hope to compete during the season. In some cases, an athlete may be moved to a different team if their individual skills are a better fit. Our staff will communicate with both the parent and athlete throughout summer practices to make sure each family understands and has input regarding the progression and performance of their athlete. Should the need arise to move an athlete up or down a level, communication with the parent and athlete will occur before any move is made.





## COMPETITION SCHEDULE

We will release our 2022-2023 competition schedule as soon as possible, but no later than the end of August. Athletes are expected to make all competitions.

## HOTELS

When you register for our program, you are agreeing to abide by any required housing policies. Hotel booking information for out-of-town competitions will be provided soon after the competition schedule is released.

## CHOREOGRAPHY


We have currently scheduled choreography at the end of July. As soon as we finalize teams, we will release team specific choreography dates. We realize many families take summer vacations and will miss some practices. However, all team members are expected to attend their entire choreography session. Please communicate with your coaches regarding planned vacations so they can plan accordingly.

## PRACTICE & ATTENDANCE

Teams will have a set schedule of 2 practices per week. Teams will practice on either Mon/Wed or Tues. / Thurs.

**All team members are expected to attend all practices.**

During certain parts of the season, extra practices will be called. Your coach will try to give you at least a two week notice regarding scheduling any extra practices. All team members are expected to attend all extra practices.



Due the first week of practice. This includes yearly registration fee (\$50.00) and three-day skills camp (June 2022). This fee is non-refundable.



### CANCELLATION FEE



## COMPETITION FEES

## **ADDITIONAL FEES**

### Additional Fees

Some additional expenses families will incur throughout the season are:

- Travel to and from competitions including lodging, spectator fees and parking. Some events may require hotel stays to be booked through their housing company.
- USASF athlete registration fee (\$40.00) when you register your athlete with the USASF. Instructions will be provided for USASF registration once teams are finalized.
- **All-Star Worlds Championship (ASW)** : Junior and Senior teams will attend The All-Star Worlds Championship, if they earn a bid throughout the season. If a team attends ASW, each team member will incur ASW registration fees as well as a small fee for Coaches travel.
- **End of Season Event:** Tiny, Mini and Youth teams as well as Junior and Senior teams that do not attend The Summit will attend an end of season event TBD. Registration fees for this event will be billed in March 2023 once it is decided which teams will be attending.

# REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS



- 1) Go to [www.azroyals.com](http://www.azroyals.com).
- 2) Click on "Parent Portal" at the top right of the page and then "Click to Begin".
- 3) Click "Log In" if you already have an account with us or "Create Account" if you have not been here before. When creating an account, you will accept our policies, enter all of your information and then add your child as a student.
- 4) Then click "Booking", click "Find a Camp", select the student you wish to enroll.
- 5) You will then choose which evaluation date you wish to attend. (April 30 or May 14th).
- 6) Once you have clicked on the date you want, click "Enroll Now!" and "Add to Cart".
- 7) After reviewing your cart and making sure the date you chose is correct, click "Store Card on File", read the policies, and click "Confirm". We do require a card on file for all enrollments, and this card can be updated/changed at any time under the "Payments" tab in your account.
- 8) You will then enter your payment information, check the box that says, "I'm not a robot" and click "Submit".
- 9) Once your evaluation payment is processed. It will then take you to a page that says, "Thank you for your purchase" and this means you have successfully completed your registration!
